



## Queensland Higher Level Skills Program Co-Contribution Fee Schedule

### HIGHER LEVEL SKILLS – Student Information Sheet

The Queensland Government's Higher Level Skills Program aims to assist individuals to gain the higher-level skills required to secure employment or career advancement in a priority industry, or to transition to university. The program provides a government subsidy to support eligible individuals to access subsidised training in selected Certificate IV or above qualifications and priority skill sets.

The nail and beauty college is approved to deliver the following Priority Skill Sets under the Higher-Level Skills funding.

### ELIGIBILITY FOR THIS TRAINING

The program is open to any Queensland resident aged 15 years or over, who is no longer at school and is an Australian or New Zealand citizen or Australian permanent resident (including humanitarian entrants), or a temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency. Prospective students must not have or be enrolled in a certificate IV or higher qualification (not including qualifications completed at school and foundation skills training).

- It is important to note that you will no longer be eligible for a government subsidised training under a funded program once you have completed a Certificate IV or higher qualification.
- In accordance with the requirements of undertaking funded training, students are required to complete a student training and employment survey within three (3) months of completing or discontinuing the skill set.

### ENROLMENT DETAILS

Once eligibility has been established you need to complete an enrolment pack. The enrolment pack will include:

- A copy of the Higher-Level Skills fact sheet



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- Higher Level Skills Student declaration form
- Request to supply evidence of residential eligibility eg: photo ID, proof of residency.
- A link to the The Nail and Beauty College LLN assessment which will need to be completed prior to the commencement of training.
- A copy of the Student Handbook
- Request to supply evidence to support concessional status if applicable.
- A copy of the course outline detailing the Units of Competency to be covered.

### STUDENT CO CONTRIBUTION FEE

Student Contribution Fees are a student’s contribution to the cost of their own training. Student Co Contribution Fees are charged in accordance with the Higher-Level Skills Program Policy 2023- 2024.

The Nail and Beauty College charges the following co-contribution fees for the courses we offer under the Higher-Level Skills program: The Student Contribution Fee is payable prior to commencement of training and is GST free.
